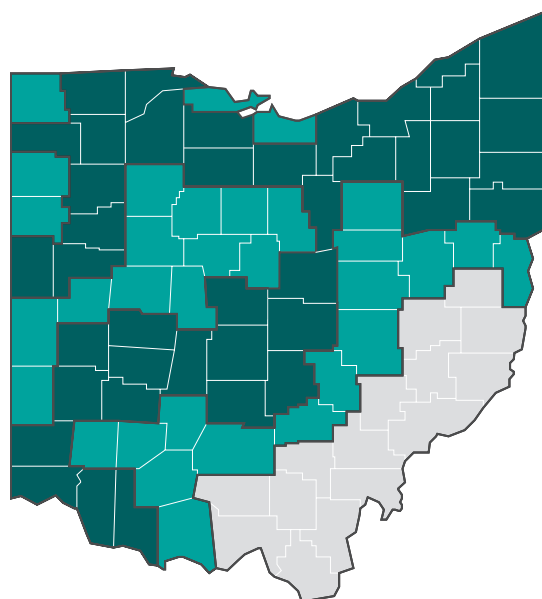
A Guide for Members

With providers in major cities, small towns and rural areas, MedFlex gives you convenient access to healthcare where you live, work and play.

In addition, MedFlex plans emphasize patient health outcomes, efficiency and quality of care which often lead to improved health and cost savings for you.

Convenient Access to In-Network Care

The MedFlex network makes it easy to get the care you need with more than 6,642 primary care physicians, 27,751 specialists and 69 hospitals across the state. It also includes specialized pediatric care for members up to age 20 at several world-class children's hospitals.

Your Benefits

MedFlex provides complete benefits, excellent care and cost control measures to help manage premiums and out-of-pocket costs. This network is a non-gatekeeper HMO, which means you don't need to coordinate care through your primary care physician (PCP). You can access specialists directly and save money. However, we do encourage you to see your PCP regularly because regular health screenings can lead to better health outcomes and help you save money.

Pharmacy Benefits

Your pharmacy benefits offer savings through generic and preferred brand name prescription drug programs through the Walgreens Advantage Network, which includes most major national and regional pharmacies, such as Walgreens and Discount Drug Mart.

Out-of-Network Restrictions

MedFlex plans only cover out-of-network benefits for medical emergencies. You will be responsible for the costs of any non-emergency care received out of network. Emergencies are always covered at any hospital regardless of network status.
