- Borrow digital media, including ebooks, magazines, movies and music from the comfort of your own home – 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Get instant access to many of the library's research databases from your home, office or school computer



How do I get a Library Card?

Anyone living, working, or attending school in Ohio may obtain a library card at any ASCPL location

- Children may obtain a library card with the consent of a parent or legal guardian
- When applying for a card, please bring a photo ID with current address
- We will accept a photo ID and another form of current address verification, such as a piece of USPS mail
