## Ambassador Services include

- Providing escorts to and from businesses and parking locations
- Reporting on potential and actual emergencies
- Working with businesses to address security/safety concerns
- Removing litter and graffiti
- Maintaining downtown planters and hanging baskets
- Providing information and directions to visitors
- Jumping car batteries and unlocking car doors for stranded motorists

Akron is truly a city within a park. The Towpath Trail Bridge (over RT 59) connects downtown Akron to the Towpath Trail and parks, trails and greenways of our region to the north. Downtown employees, residents and visitors can utilize the trail by getting on and off at Lock 1, Lock 2, Lock 3, State St., Bowery & Quaker St., the Towpath Bridge, Beech St. and the Mustill Store.
